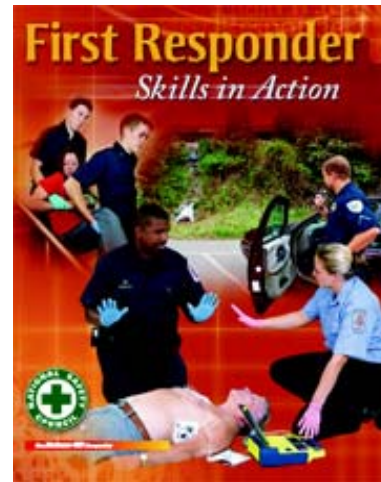
First Responder/Remote Care and CPR
