Congratulations! We have received your registration for Readyman. Please read this acceptance notice carefully.

The registration desk opens at 8am and you should be registered and ready for activities by 9am. This is important: Activities will start promptly at 9am, and the youth will be in class by 9:15 !

When you registered you received payment instructions. We prefer a credit card payment, but will also take a mail in check. Your registration is final once we receive your payment. **After May 1st unpaid registrations may be cancelled** if there is a wait list! We recommend you pay as soon as possible after registering.

We need to prepare materials for most classes so we ask that there be no walk in participants.

Cubs that are in the process of transitioning to Webelos are welcome to attend. The activity is for all year groups. The cost is \$15 per Webelos. Adults and adult leaders are \$5. Lunch will be provided to all.

There is no rain date for this activity. Activities will proceed regardless of weather. The boys will be released by 4pm with a very full schedule. Everyone should plan on attending all activities. Unfortunately, we cannot issue the Readyman award for partial attendance. If your boy will miss parts of the Academy due to other commitments that day it is probably better that we leave that slot open for a boy who can attend the entire activity.

Participants should wear their uniform, and bring a jacket for expected weather. If Webelos do not have a baseball cap then one might be useful in case of a sunny day. Some activities will

be outdoors. They should bring a canteen or water bottle. Sunscreen may be appropriate, and a small daypack to carry things is very useful. Adult leaders may participate in all activities and assist with the leadership of the boys.

Adult Leaders: We will have coffee available, but we ask that you bring your travel mug or coffee cup with you. Many adults bring a folding chair for use during the outdoor events.
